Understanding the different contexts

- National: where we are in terms of God's purposes for Israel
- · Individual: where we are in the book.



Pulling it all together

Things to avoid when applying OT narrative

- · Don't jump into the story!
- Don't draw straight line applications between the characters in the story and us.
- Don't raise false hopes and expectations.

Things to include when applying OT narrative

- · What we learn about God.
- How the narrative points forward to Jesus.
- The positive (or negative) examples of faith to learn from.
